NEW PORT RICHEY, Fla. – Pasco County Public Works officials are continuing to monitor localized flooding throughout the county and will continue through the night.

The shelter at Saint Marks Presbyterian Church located east of US 19 on SR 52 has closed at this time.

Residents should anticipate the potential for standing water in areas normally susceptible to flooding during long rain events. Standing water is still impacting several streets and intersections. These locations are barricaded. Residents are urged not to drive around the barricades through the standing water.

A Flash Flood Watch remains in effect for Pasco County until Thursday.

Pasco County is offering sandbags to residents in need. Sandbags can be picked up at the Public Works building at 7536 State St., in the West Pasco County Government Center, New Port Richey.
